



# Dishwashing Procedure

3 steps to effective Automatic Dishwashing

## 1

### Set Up Procedures

- Ensure the scrap trays are clean and in place.
- Make sure all drains are closed.
- Fill the machine with water.
- Check for correct temperature
- Check detergent & rinse aid product levels and replace if needed.
- Run an empty wash cycle to ensure everything is working correctly.

### Daily Warewash Procedures

#### SOAK

- Remove all food scraps from plates and dishes and rinse with water.
- Items with stubborn stains should be soaked in Destainer Powder
- Avoid using manual dishwashing detergent.

#### RACK

- Organise plates, cups and bowls according to size.
- Plates should be placed positioned leaning backwards.
- Cups, glasses and bowls must be placed upside down.
- Do not overload the cutlery rack.



#### WASH

- Allow racks to complete the full wash cycle. Do not open door or push racks through the dishwasher.

#### DRY

- Allow all washed items time to dry after exiting the machine.

## 3

### Clean Up Procedures

- Turn off the dishwasher.
- Empty and clean the scrap trays.
- Remove and rinse wash arms and rinse jets; ensure they are unblocked.
- Wipe out the interior of the dishwasher.
- Clean the dishwasher exterior, including doors and control panels.
- Remove any debris or blockages from filters.
- Empty and rinse the drain.
- Sanitise the interior and exterior surfaces.
- Clean the surrounding work area and mop the floor.
- ⚠️ Appropriate PPE should be worn at all times.
